## CHANGES TO THE BYLAWS

At the May meeting, the Board approved two Bylaws amendments that several members had requested. These amendments will be officially announced at the May General Membership Meeting, to be voted on at the June meeting. If approved by the membership in June, they will become part of the Club's Bylaws immediately.

**Proposed amendment #1:** to add the following to Article VI of the Bylaws:

Section 4. Since the General Membership Meeting is a business meeting as well as a social meeting of the AVSCC membership, attendance is limited to members in good standing, with the following exceptions:

- a) Spouses or other partners of members in good standing may accompany their spouses to meetings.
- b) Care-givers to members are welcome to accompany members.
- c) Guests invited by the Board, or its designee, or the Executive Committee, as part of the program, for purpose of recognition, or other purpose appropriate to a General Membership meeting are welcome.

For the purpose of this Article, "membership" shall include Associate Members and those holding temporary membership in consideration of applying for membership or as house guests of members, as well as full voting Members.

**Proposed Amendment #2:** to add the following to Article VI of the Bylaws (except that should Proposed Amendment #1 fail. Proposed Amendment #2 shall be renumbered as Section 4):

Section 5: Any loan in excess of \$20,000, or encumbrance to the real property of AVSCC, shall require approval by majority vote of the AVSCC membership at any properly convened regular or special General Membership meeting.
