## Apple Valley Senior Citizens Club Code of Conduct

The AVSCC Code of Conduct is based on the Golden Rule and common sense.

At the Apple Valley Senior Citizens Club (AVSCC), we expect our Members, Associate Members, and guests to behave in accordance with our mission and the four core values of "Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility." There will be a zero tolerance for those in conflict with these rules.

- 1) Disabled parking spaces are to be utilized exclusively by vehicles displaying a disabled plate or placard.
- 2) To create a safe environment, firearms and illegal devices or substances are not permitted on Club property or at Club events. This includes those who have a permit to carry weapons. Authorized security personnel may be permitted to be armed, subject to AVSCC Board's approval.
- 3) Possession or use of narcotics and alcohol is not permitted on Club property or at Club events.
- 4) Theft or destruction of AVSCC, Inc property is not permitted.
- 5) Members and guests shall speak in respectful tones and avoid abusive, derogatory obscene and vulgar language to an individual person or against AVSCC, Inc. policies or procedures.
- 6) Improper, intimate behavior or intentional sexual contact is not permitted.
- 7) Shouting, threatening gesture, or actual physical attack upon an individual is not permitted.
- 8) Smoking is not permitted within the confines of the AVSCC building. The smoking area is designated as area near horseshoe/shuffleboard pits at exterior of building.
- 9) Electronic smoking devices ("vaping") are not permitted.

Dress Code: Members and guests are expected to abide by the following dress code at all times when on Club property or at Club events:

- 1) Clean dress appropriate for the occasion.
- 2) No provocative wording or images on clothing.
- 3) No bare midriffs.

Non-compliance with this Code of Conduct may result in consequences including a letter of admonishment to be filed in the defendant's club record, or suspension or revocation of membership. Action taken will be based upon the recommendations of the Grievance Committee, with the final action determined by the AVSCC Board of Directors. Any action taken must be in compliance with California state law, and the AVSCC Charter, By-laws, and Standing Rules.

**Procedures for Handling Complaints:**

All complaints must be based on a legitimate, serious offense. Filing of frivolous complaints could result in an admonishment to the complainant. All complaints shall be subject to arbitration by the Grievance Committee and the parties involved.

All complaints must be made in writing, dated and signed by the complainant. The complaint must be submitted to the AVSCC Recording Secretary within 30 days of the event; the Secretary will log in the complaint and forward it to the Grievance Committee within 5 days of receipt. Complainant and defendant shall notify Grievance Committee as to names and phone numbers of witnesses whom they wish to appear.

The Grievance Committee will promptly contact the complainant, defendant and appropriate witnesses and set a time and date for the hearing, which should be held within 30 days, unless delayed by unavailability of interested parties.

If the complainant fails to appear or cooperate in the hearing, the complaint shall be dismissed. If the defendant fails to appear, the Grievance committee will proceed with the hearing, giving due consideration to defendants rights.

The Grievance Committee's report and recommendation shall be submitted to the Recording Secretary within 5 days of the hearing, and shall be added to the agenda for the next special or regularly scheduled Board meeting, to be heard in closed session. At that meeting, the Board shall accept or reject the recommendation as submitted, modify the recommendation, or return the complaint to the committee for clarification or further information. Upon final action on a complaint, the Recording Secretary shall notify all parties involved of its decision in writing within 10 days.
